The first revision on the right 'cleans up' the original sentence and is perfectly grammatical. However, it breaks the usual expectation that the Topic (here, 'Recruitment', as announced by the heading) should come before the Comment (the use of Advertising).¹ . The second revision shows an attempt to make the Topic - Comment structure clearer. It involves two collocations: 'carry out + recruitment' (no examples in my data), and 'place + advertisement':
